Survivor Thrivers
By-Laws
No. 1

A by-law relating generally to the transactions of the affairs of the Survivor Thrivers-Breast Cancer Survivors Society, a corporation without share capital incorporated under The Ontario Corporations Act (Ontario Corporation Number 1347033). By-law revisions are based on Ontario's Not-for-profit Corporations Act 2010 (ONCA).

BE IT ENACTED ("the Corporation"); be hereinafter referred to as "Survivor Thrivers".

Objectives

- i. Our goal is to survive, thrive and have fun as we promote breast cancer awareness and prevention
- ii. Improve physical and emotion health of all our team members by exercise and supportive camaraderie at every practice, race and group meeting
- iii. Support team members and their families who are experiencing problems related to cancer
- iv. Increase local public awareness of breast cancer through our activities: dragon boat racing, support group, talks and presentations, and involvement in local community events
- v. Increase national public awareness of breast cancer survivors' needs by communicating and combining efforts with other breast cancer survivor dragon boat teams
- vi. Fundraise to support our breast cancer dragon boat team and to give back to relevant organizations that meet the mandate of the Survivor Thrivers.
- vii. Consideration will be given to compete in dragon boat festivals where profits/part of the profits are given to charity.

Head Office

1. The head office of the Survivor Thrivers will be at the address of the current President in the Province of Ontario. The Executive may, from time to time, determine the specific location of the head office.

Seal

2. There shall be a corporate seal for the Survivor Thrivers. An imprint of the corporate seal is impressed in the margin.

Fiscal Year

3. The fiscal year of the Survivor Thrivers shall begin on March 1st of each year and end on the last day of February the following year.

Membership

4. The Survivor Thrivers shall consist of the following persons who pay an annual membership:
 - i) Persons diagnosed with breast cancer (Survivors) and
 - ii) Persons who support the objectives of the Survivor Thrivers but not diagnosed with breast cancer (Supporters)
 - iii) Both to be referred to herineafter as "Members".
